## SERVICE ABOVE SELF

Our members actively participate in projects, activities and club committees that serve young people and people of all ages with disabilities, carrying out the Rotary motto of “Service Above Self.” Two hallmarks of our community service are:

- Rochester Rotary Sunshine Camp, a free, residential summer camp meeting the needs of children with physical disabilities and their families. 5,700 people from more than 75 not-for-profit organizations use the facility every year.
- Our partnership with Roberto Clemente School #8. Rochester Rotarians are at School #8, nearly every day, tutoring students, reading to them, providing library books or winter clothing, offering field trips to area businesses and mentoring. Rotary also provides scholarship opportunities for School #8 students.

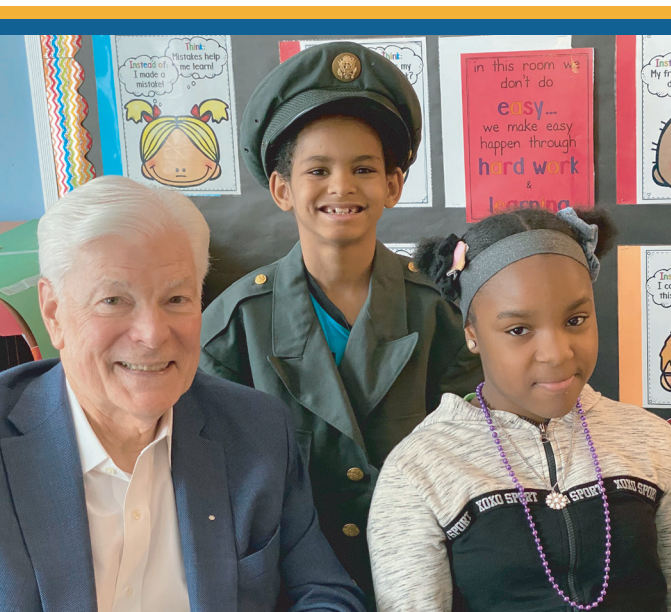
## ADVANTAGES OF MEMBERSHIP
